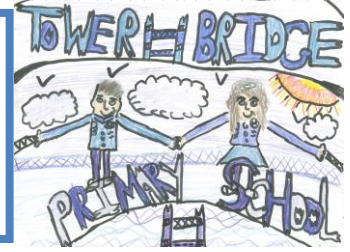


TOWER BRIDGE SCHOOL NEWSLETTER
