SCIENCE MUSEUM TRIP

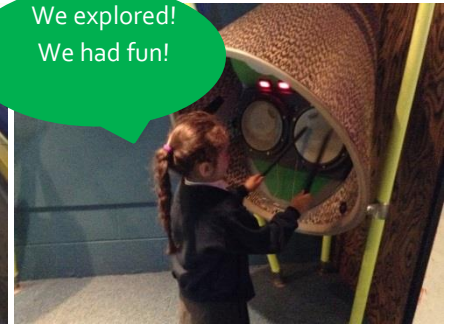
We are going to the Science Museum!
