There is an exciting new learning activity at Southwark Libraries called **Maths Challenge!** which might be of interest to you.

The Maths Challenge is a series of free mathematical workshops delivered at Camberwell Library by vetted volunteers from **Kings College London Maths School**. The workshops will be held on Saturdays from 11:30am - 12:30pm starting on Saturday 28th November 2015 for ten weeks in the first instance. The purpose of the Maths Challenge is to spark a mathematical interest and curiosity in KS2 and KS3 students (aged 10 - 14) by exposing them to a variety of problems in different and unfamiliar contexts. Students will also have the opportunity to receive help and support with their homework. The contents of the problems within the workshops will be tailored to as many areas of the National Curriculum as possible. Students attending the sessions will learn about various types of mathematics and how it can be applied. They will also develop problem solving skills by discussing mathematical problems with the volunteers and each other. In addition to the Maths Challenge they provide weekly Homework Help Clubs throughout their libraries.

Year 1 and Year 2 will be performing "The Jolly Christmas Postman".


Performance this year is on Tuesday 15th December at 2pm
