

# Assessment at Tower Bridge

## KEY STAGE 2

## PROGRESS FROM KS1 TO KS2

Until 2016 the expectation was that every child should make at least two full levels of progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2. This shows the percentage who were able to do this. From 2016, progress was compared to children nationally, using average point scores. Most schools will fall between -5 and +5, with the average being 0. The national floor targets were -5 for reading and maths and -7 for writing.
