Hate Crime Awareness Assembly

Blue and Purple classes attended a special assembly led by our Community Officer PC Dominic Williams. The children were made aware of the different types of hate crimes and the impact these would have on our community. They also discussed the negative effects discrimination might have on individuals or groups.
