### Footpaths Closures

We have been informed by Network Rail that as part of the Thameslink Programme, work is needed to refurbish the footways and kerbing on and around the five way junction at the southern entrance of the Bermondsey Street tunnel. To allow these works to take place and protect members of the public, they will require several full footpath closures. Diversionary routes will be clearly indicated during these times.

They have staggered the work so that only one footpath will be closed at a time to lessen the impact on members of the public. The dates shown below indicate pavement areas that will be closed. Work will take place during normal working hours.

Dates	Closure area
20 March – 30 March	St Thomas Street (south side) at junction with Snowsfields
3 April – 10 April	Snowsfields (south side) at junction with Bermondsey Street
11 April – 21 April	Bermondsey Street (west side) at junction with Snowsfields
24 April – 30 April	Crucifix Lane (south side) at junction with Bermondsey Street
1 May – 5 May	Bermondsey Street (east side) at junction with Crucifix Lane
8 May – 11 May	Crucifix Lane (north side) at junction with Bermondsey Street
12 May – 26 May	St Thomas Street (north side) at junction with Bermondsey Street
