Congratulations to these children who received postcards in assembly this week.

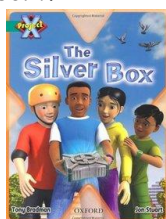
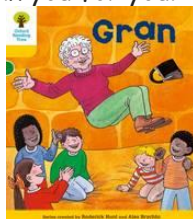
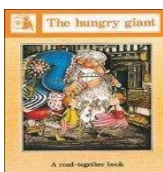


Book Amnesty
