We return to school on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> April.

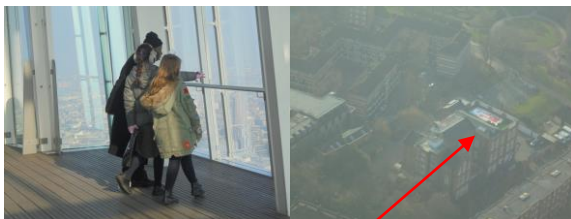
### Spring Fair
