Discover your local neighbourhood through an alternative sense! Join on Saturday 2nd July, for a fun walk in Peckham to explore another side to this much-loved neighbourhood.

Bring: a pen, bottle of water, comfy shoes and curiosity

As we walk through our cities we receive and process information about our surroundings primarily through our eyes. But what happens if instead of recording and responding to the sights of a town we alternatively choose to foreground the sense of smell? Smellwalking, or walking 'nose-first', proposes a new knowledge of place and this workshop is designed to enable participants to discover the 'hidden smellscape' of Peckham.

Similarly, we walk, sit and ride through the city immersed in sound, but only paying attention to some of it. The soundwalk aims to draw our complete attention back to this world of sound, unblocking the filters we've set up for ourselves. How does a different type of attention change the way we feel about our everyday places? What new things can we learn about Peckham from the way it sounds? We will reveal what a neighbourhood's sounds and smells tell us about the social, cultural and economic processes at work in the area.
