Attendance and Term Dates

A change in the law means that Local Authorities can issue penalty notices to parents where their children have absences not authorised by the Headteacher, this includes term time holidays. The fine is £60 per parent and has to be paid within 21 days. As of September 2015 the government has raised the absence threshold to 90%. Therefore parents are at greater risk of possible legal proceedings. This law has been introduced because absences from school can damage your child's learning.

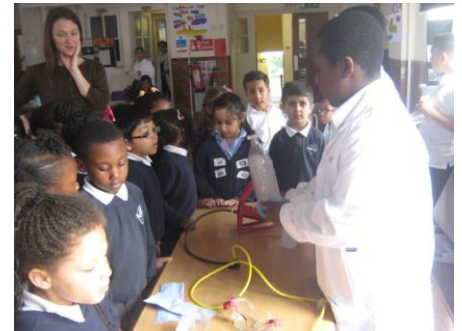
Classes earn points for the best attendance or punctuality.
