Keeping Healthy Parents Workshop

Both children and Parents had the opportunity to explore and discuss the school's new PE scheme of work 'Real PE' with Lara our PE subject leader. This approach has proven extremely popular amongst the children as it teaches the fundamental movement skills and promotes whole child development not just the physical aspects in a fun and engaging way.



Healthy eating recipes and ideas were shared with the parents, who were quite surprised to find out that an average breakfast cereal box contains the equivalent of 34 sugar cubes.
