

- Provision of a new 900 student secondary school and 250 student sixth form college to meet the increasing demand for school places in the local area.
- 199 much needed high quality new homes in the restored Fire station buildings and a new residential development on the boundary with Sawyer Street.
- Preservation of the site's historic listed features while bringing the site back into active use.
- New commercial and community space on Southwark Bridge Road.
- New landscaping and public realm to improve the appearance of the site.
- Construction of a new sports hall which will be accessible for school pupils and the wider local community.
