Think Before you Click

In keeping with our Acceptable User Policy (AUP) and all the e-safety rules you have been taught at school about responsible ICT use, below are some pointers for you to remember while learning from home.

- I will only use the internet, email and Twitter with the permission of my trusted adults at home.
- If I see something I don't like on screen, I will always tell an adult.
- I will not open an attachment, or download a file, unless I have permission or I know and trust the person who has sent it.
- If I see anything I am unhappy with or I receive a message I do not like, I will not respond to it and I will tell a teacher / trusted adult at home. I will also report it through clicking on the REPORT ABUSE icon where available.

- CREATE A FAMILY GOOGLE ACCOUNT:** Advises parents to create a family group to manage children's accounts.
- GET YOUR OWN ACCOUNT:** Advises children to get their own accounts with parental supervision.
- BE MEMBER OF CYBERBULLYING:** Warns about cyberbullying and provides resources.
- GET TO KNOW POPULAR CHANNELS:** Advises parents to know what their children are watching.
- DON'T ASSUME YOUR CHILD IS TOO YOUNG:** Warns that children can be more sophisticated than they appear.

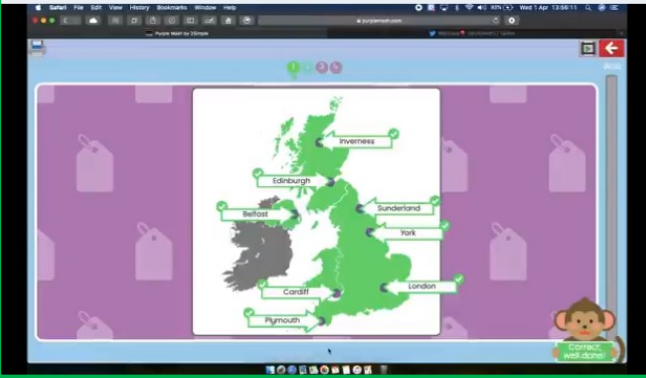

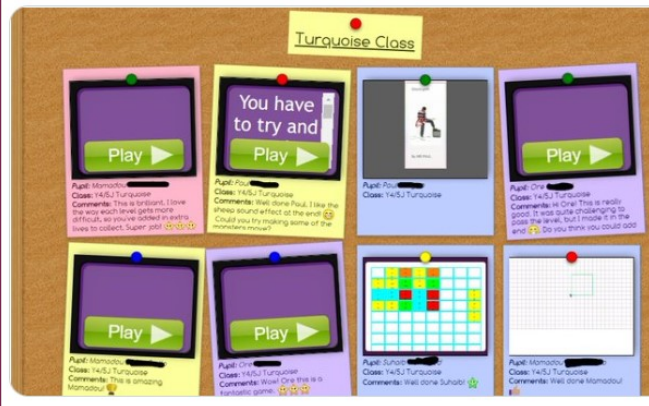
