# Speech and Language Provision for Robert Browning Families during school closures

Speech and Language Therapist, Emma Jones, is still providing support to children with Speech, Language and Communication needs during the period of school closure. Emma is able to work in many ways with you as a parent/carer. This may be:

regular phone calls with you (parent/carer)

regular video calls with you (parent/carer) to give you ideas and advice while playing / doing an activity with your child

sending links and online activities for the child to do with you (with our help over the phone) video calls with you and the child, to talk you through an activity or do the activity together working directly with your child through a video call where activities are shared on the screen (and you watch / join in)

sending activities by email / post with a video tutorial to show you how to do an activity assessing speech, language and communication needs / observation through video calling

Over the recent weeks, Emma has been contacting parents and carers of children who she had been working with prior to the school closures. ### Information for those attending SLT drop-in

The speech and language therapy drop-in for your school will be held every Monday between 10am and 1pm. The drop-in will be held using our video appointment service called Attend Anywhere.

You can access the online video consultation/appointment via 'Safari' or 'Google Chrome' on your mobile phone/ tablet /laptops. You will need to have a working webcam, speakers and built in microphone if you are using a laptop/tablet. When preparing for the appointment, please sit in an area with good natural lighting and minimal background noise (where possible). If your child will be present for the session it may be helpful for you to sit up to a table to ensure the camera remains steady and we can see you clearly.

When you sign in for the video appointment, please log in using 'SLT drop-in'+ child's name and DOB so we know that you have arrived.

It's a good idea to test the link above ahead of the appointment time to make sure it works. Please call 02030498057 or email <a href="mailto:Amber.Scott@gstt.nhs.uk">Amber.Scott@gstt.nhs.uk</a>, <a href="mailto:Nicola.spray@gstt.nhs.uk">Nicola.spray@gstt.nhs.uk</a> directly if you have any issues on the day of the appointment.

The drop-in appointments will be offered on a 'first come, first served' basis so please continue to wait until the speech and language therapist is able to see you. The drop-ins are offered for a number of schools at the same time.



Disney+ is the latest big player in the TV streaming market. The global brand has released its own subscription-based streaming service to rival that of competitors such as Netflix, Amazon Prime and Apple TV. As the name might suggest, it's designed to be family friendly, with content restricted to PG and PG-13 (UK equivalent 12a). It can be streamed on pretty much any device – mobile phones, tablets, PC's, TVs and games consoles – and features a huge library of classic Disney titles. Below, we've highlighted a few tips for parents to consider to ensure that their children get the most enjoyable




















Whilst the ability to stream on almost any device capable of connecting to the internet might seem great at first, parents may also want to exercise a little bit of caution. Parental controls on Disney+ are quite limited and there are no settings to help with screen time or usage, so it can be easy for children to binge watch, particularly given the amount of content available. Apple, Google and Amazon devices all provide options to limit children's screen time so parents can manage how long their child uses the app.

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### Enable 'Kid's Profile' mode

Although Disney+ is billed as family friendly, there is still an option to enable a 'kid's profile' which removes all PG and PG-13 rated content. This adds an extra level of safety if you're still concerned that your child may watch something that could be deemed too 'intense' for their age. Setting up a kid's profile also switches off autoplay which means the next video in any series won't automatically play once one episode has finished. It should be noted though that children can easily switch between accounts themselves given there is no security required to get into profiles.



#### Double check for films with outdated cultural depictions

The Disney+ service includes programs and movies that go back to the 1920s and which have been left in their original format, with their original contains cultural insensitivities and depictions that were included in the original show, but Disney would never include them now. For example, cultural stereotyping, the representation of minority groups or character portrayals which may be deemed racist. For this reason, viewers are made aware through a warning message stating "This program is presented as originally created. It may contain outdated cultural depictions." Whilst Disney do their best to highlight any such content, it's always worth discussing these issues with your child if they raise any queries. child if they raise any queries.
