

In addition to the above slot, it is a possibility that your child will be timetabled for a second PE slot each week and so their class teacher will inform you when this might be happening.

COVID-19 UPDATE

We hope you and your families have had a lovely summer and are all well and keeping safe. It was so nice to see those of you who returned to school this week. We hope you have settled back into the school routine and are feeling more reassured and less anxious.

Each week this page will contain any new updates linked to our procedures and protocols around COVID19.

Our intention that the school will run as normally as possible within the current Government Guidance. All children will be expected to attend. School will be compulsory again and families who don't attend may face fines. At the moment there will be no school clubs after school in the Autumn Term.

Monday 7th September

We will be welcoming our new Reception children and children who will continue in our nursery (Early Birds) Breakfast Club and After School Club opens

Drop off and pick up

You must drop off your child between 8.45am and 9.15am. This will mean that we can continue to stagger the arrival of all our families.

You must collect your child at the end of the day between 3pm and 3.30pm.

All children will be brought to the playground at the end of the day.

Only 1 parent is allowed to drop off/collect their child/ren.

Please make sure you are social distancing from other families.

Once you have dropped off or collected your child please move away from the school gates.

Visitors and parents/carers cannot enter the site and/or gather at school gates.

Please continue to phone and email us if you need to share information or ask questions. You will not have the usual daily contact with the teaching staff. We will not be sending home letters etc. and minimising any face to face contact. We will call or email you instead (this includes if your child has an accident).

The School Day

All children must wear school uniform. They can wear PE kit to school on the days they have PE.

The children will be allowed to bring in a water bottle and their book bags and bring books home again.

Phase or floor bubbles have been created. Children don't have to social distance in their bubbles.

Where possible children will sit in rows facing the front.

Staff do have to maintain social distancing. Some adults will be moving between bubbles and between schools, but this will be limited.

We will be following our normal school timetable and curriculum. We will plan interventions to help children catch up on the learning they have missed this year.

Lunchtimes will be back in the dinner hall and will be staggered so only one bubble is in the hall at a time. Tables and benches will then be cleaned before the next class enters.

Playtimes will be staggered and bubbles will be allocated an area of the playground to use.

Other professionals will be coming into school to work with children and families. They will follow the most up to date guidance. Many of the current protocols will continue; hygiene and frequent hand washing/hand gel, frequent cleaning, keep your distance and keep moving in shared areas such as corridors and staircases.

Responding to a suspected case of Coronavirus

Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell. If they have a high temperature, loss of smell or taste or a new, continuous, dry cough, please let us know and book your child to be tested immediately. There are a list of other symptoms available on the NHS and Government website.

Anyone displaying Coronavirus symptoms in school will be sent home immediately and will need to follow the Government guidelines for self isolation.

- Child with symptoms will be sent home and must arrange a test
- Siblings will be sent home
- Other families in the class/bubble will be notified
- Other children in that group can continue to come to school until the test results are back

If the test is positive, the symptomatic child must self- isolate for 7 days, siblings for 14 days and the same group children and staff for 14 days. We will also notify Public Health England in Southwark for further guidance

If negative, the child can return when better

If parents refuse to test their child, we will notify Public Health England in Southwark who will follow this up with the family, GP and complete a risk assessment. They will advise the school on our next steps.
