- They will also have the range of homework projects they can complete. You will have received this sheet at the beginning of term.
- A member of staff will contact you regularly to offer support and feedback with your child's learning
- If you are able to, please Tweet any work or activities that your child has completed. Teachers check Twitter every day.
- Please contact the school if your child has completed all the work. It can then be returned to school for marking and you will be given another pack.

- Any materials that have been sent home for your child to complete **must be returned on the day they return to school**
