

KS1 and KS2 Home Learning Expectations - Parents

The following are the expectations for KS1 and KS2 classes if a bubble has to close or there are wider school closures.

- We teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school, with between 3 and 4 hours of learning each day.
- Please help your child by trying to set a daily routine. We know this can be extremely challenging and we will do everything we can to support you.
- Each morning, a short video will be posted to Twitter with details of the activities for that day. Please watch the video, so that you understand the outline of the day.
- One English, Maths and Reading activity will be assigned per day. This may be on any of our learning platforms (Google Classroom, Reading Eggs, Mathletics, Purple Mash, ReadiWriter) or any combination of those platforms. The teacher will make it clear where the work can be found in their Twitter video or on Google Classroom.
- One curriculum subject (topic) activity will be assigned per day on Google Classroom or Purple Mash.
- Don't forget to complete the range of homework projects too. You will have received this sheet at the beginning of term and it is also on Google Classroom.
- Teachers will use a range of approaches; mainly digital and practical activities and recorded teaching.
- If your child has Special Educational Needs the teacher will be setting differentiated work.
- Any work that is handed in on any of the learning platforms will be looked at by the teacher and, if needed, will be returned with an improvement prompt comment. Pupils will need to re-submit their work once they have edited it.
- Teachers will also give Shout Outs to children on Twitter.
- We expect all children to complete the learning set each day. We will contact you if your child is not engaging to see how we can support you and ensure your child does not miss out on their learning and fall behind.
- Any questions you have about the work can be posted on Google Classroom so the teacher can respond.
- If you are unable to access the home learning please contact the school immediately to see how we can help you. You may need to borrow a device, need access to wifi or data or require a paper pack.
