

EYFS Home Learning Expectations - Parents

The following are the expectations for Nursery and Reception classes if a bubble has to close or there are wider school closures.

1. A short video posted to Twitter each morning to detail the activities for that day.
2. Each day there will be a balance of practical and online learning.
3. Children can access activities on Google Classroom which support each Area of Learning in EYFS for each day children are at home.
4. Reception classes: Maths (Purple Mash), Teach Your Monster to Read and Reading Eggs activities will also be assigned.
5. Nursery children also have a login to purple mash in order to explore the mini mash area with parents/carers.
6. Any work that children do at home can be shared with the teacher 'in their virtual tray' on Google Classroom.
7. Twitter will be used to celebrate children's achievements.
8. Information for parents and carers on Google Classroom – there is a specific area dedicated to advise parents on children's development, benefits of a daily routine, mental health and well-being and keeping active and the expectations for parents
9. Any questions you have about the work can be posted on Google Classroom so the teacher can respond.
10. If you have any other questions or want to speak to a member of staff please phone the school office.

Your attention and quality interactions with your child have the biggest impact on every aspect of their development and this should be the focus during any school/class closure. Everyday routines and activities are learning for our children too.

- Keep a daily routine with times set aside for self-care (eating, sleeping, brushing teeth etc), short (10 minute) activities you engage in **with** your child and lots of play breaks for them.
- Encourage your child to do certain things independently – getting dressed (doing zips!) tidying away their toys etc.
