## The Big Ask

The Big Ask is a survey for children and young people aged 4–17 in England. The survey is split into different age groups, so you can support your child to fill in a version appropriate for their age. Helping your child to complete the survey will give them a chance to have their say on the things that matter to them. They can share what their life is like, what they want in the future and anything they think is holding them back. What they say will be used to tell the people who run the country or your local area what your child thinks needs to change to make their life better.

The survey will not ask for your child's name, phone number or email address and they will keep the information shared safe and private – it won't be shared with anyone else. The children don't have to answer any question if they don't want to.

## Clothing Grant Voucher Scheme

In order to apply, families must be residing in Southwark and have a child aged 11 years old who will be transferring from primary school to a secondary state or voluntary aided school in Southwark in September 2021.
