

#### To: Parents/carers of children in primary schools

Dear Parent/Carer,

The NHS is offering children aged 1 to 9 in London a polio vaccine. This will either be a booster on top of your child's routine immunisations or a catch up dose.

There are signs <u>polio</u> may be spreading in London and the number of children vaccinated in London is lower than it should be. Boosting immunity in children should help protect them and reduce the risk of the virus continuing to spread. The NHS will contact you with information on how to book an appointment.



#### Make sure your child is up to date on their other vaccinations for the new school year

As we return for another school year, it is important to make sure that your child is up to date with their childhood immunisations, particularly if they are joining primary school for the first time.

Your child should have had the **pre-school booster**, and two doses of **MMR** before they start school. Check your child's **red book** (personal health record) to see if your child has had their jabs.

It is also recommended that children aged 5 and over get a dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, and take up the offer of the flu vaccine when offered it in school, in order to stay safe and well this winter.


